Sexual Integrity for Men – Summer 2008 Lies Worksheet

Part of the "deceitfulness of sin" is that we begin to believe things that are not true (Rom 1:25 – we exchanged the truth of God for the lie). Unless we take our thoughts captive to the obedience of Christ (1 Cor 10:5) we will live under the sway of things that are not true. In this exercise, we expose some of the lies that typify sexual addiction, stand the truth up against them, and garner scriptural support for that truth. In this way, we can be "transformed by the renewing of our minds" (Rom. 12:2).

Read these over, and prayerfully apply these truths to the lies that you've believed (if the shoe fits). Also, add some of your own lies to the end of this table, and put the truth alongside of them. We'll share some of your insights in class.
